Must be 21 years of age. Must also be able to pass an extensive background investigation, psychological exam, and polygraph exam. Must take and pass a drug screening. Must be able to work 12-hour shifts (day, night, overnight, holidays, overtime). English language preferred; bilingual ability a plus. Starting pay \$18.00/hour with generous benefit plan.
