## AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE



### From the Pembroke Department of Public Safety

Though temperatures are starting to climb, cold and Flu season are still upon us. Below are some helpful tips on how you can protect yourself against infection.

-  NO handshaking. Use a fist bump or elbow bump instead.
-  Use **ONLY** your knuckle to touch light switches, elevator buttons, etc. Lift the gasoline dispenser with a paper towel or use a disposable glove.
-  Open doors with your closed fist or hip. Do not grasp doorknobs with your hand, unless there is no other way to open the door. This is especially important in high traffic public places.
-  Use disinfectant wipes at stores when they are available, including wiping the handle and child seat in grocery carts.
-  Wash your hands with soap for 10–20 seconds and/or use a greater than 60% alcohol-based hand sanitizer whenever you return home.
-  Keep a bottle of sanitizer available at each of your home's entrances AND in your vehicle for use after touching items in public places.
-  Cough or sneeze into a disposable tissue and discard. Use your elbow only if you have to, as clothing can contain bacteria that can be passed on for up to a week or more.
