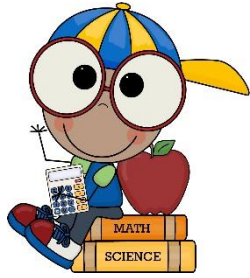

If you look up at the intersection of Ash Branch and Sims Rd, you'll see that the City of Pembroke has nearly completed a year-long project of doubling our water system capacity!

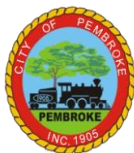
