

## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Pembroke is considering applying to the Georgia Department of Community Affairs for a Community Development Block Grant of up to \$750,000. These funds must be used to primarily benefit low and moderate income persons.

The activities for which these funds may be used are in the areas of housing, public facilities, and economic development. More specific details regarding eligible activities, plans to assist displaced persons (if any), the estimated amount of funds proposed to be used for activities to benefit low and moderate income persons, and the rating system will be provided at a public hearing which will be held at the Pembroke City Hall, 160 North Main Street, Pembroke, Georgia 31321 on February 5, 2020 at 11:00 a.m.

The purpose of this hearing will be to obtain citizen input into the development of the application and to review progress on the previous CDBG grant (if applicable).
