What is Unclaimed Property?

Unclaimed property refers to accounts held by financial institutions and other businesses who have lost contact with their owner of record. Unclaimed property includes, but is not limited to wages, savings accounts, customer refunds, accounts payable, insurance payments, shares of stock, escrow funds, royalties, and contents from safe deposit boxes. Most property is reported to the program after five years of inactivity.

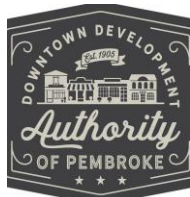
How do I search for my Unclaimed Property in Georgia?

1. Go to the [Unclaimed Property Search](#)
2. You will need your name and Social Security Number to begin the search.
3. If you are required to submit a printed Claim Form, please see Section C of the form for additional required documentation.

New Fees for 2022!!

Beginning in January 2022, the monthly price for trash cans will change to \$13.00 per can for residential accounts, and \$16.00 per can for commercial accounts. This rate increase is necessary due to an increase in contract pricing for pick-up services.

Annual Community-Wide Notice Regarding Flood Prevention

CITY OF PEMBROKE / NORTH BRYAN COUNTY

KNOW YOUR FLOOD FACTS!!

Are you prepared if we have a tornado, hurricane, or major storm in our area?

These facts could help save your life and your property. **BE PREPARED!**

FLOOD PREVENTION STEPS

Your property may be subject to flooding – check with Bryan County Planning & Zoning or call City Hall in Pembroke at 912-653-4413 for more information. Even if you do not have a mortgage on your property, you may want flood insurance to protect your home and your property.

Renters should buy flood insurance for their contents – your contents are not covered under your landlord's insurance. Check with your local insurance company to see if you need to protect your personal belongings.

Don't drive into flooding areas

protect yourself and others from the hazard of flooded areas.

Clean out debris and trash from ditches to protect your property – help prevent flooding of your property and others.

Cleaning debris and trash will allow better water drainage.

Get a permit from "BOTH" The City of Pembroke and Bryan County Planning and Zoning before you build – building permits *must* be obtained from both the City and the County for the protection of wetlands and to verify whether you are building in a flood zone.

Report broken silt fences to help keep streams clean – silt fencing helps protect the natural floodplain functions

Know your evacuation route – in an emergency you need to know the safest route for evacuation of you and your family. Be prepared. Know your evacuation route and have a predetermined family meeting place plan in place.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Information on elevation certificates, flood zones, wetlands, public assistance, property protection advice, property protection visits, etc. are available through Bryan County Planning and Zoning Office at 912-653-3893.

Download the Federal **FEMA** app by your smartphone for free and Ready.ga.gov is also a free app for Georgia.

Through the GEMA, an arrangement has been made with Peach State Radio and the Georgia Public Radio Network, to broadcast evacuation and other emergency information over all Peach State Radio stations. The Bryan County station is 89.1FM.
