Railroad Street

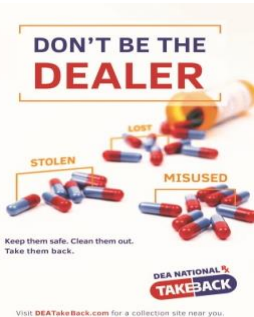

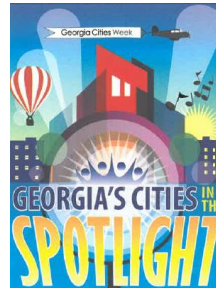
EASTER EGGSTRAVAGANZA!!
