Referendum Notice



The City of Pembroke has been asked to consider the issue of Package Stores within City Limits. This referendum requires signatures from 35% of the registered city voters who voted in the last general election (November 2016). Petitions for allowing package stores can be signed at City Hall and have also been distributed to your Council representatives. Residents are encouraged to consider this as an unexplored revenue source regardless of their feelings towards liquor. The zoning of these stores would follow the Georgia laws regarding distances from schools, daycares, churches, etc.
