Did you know — Mayor Pro-Tem Tiffany Zeigler accepted a \$914k check today on behalf of the City of Pembroke at the Georgia Department of Community Affairs fall Conference in Augusta, Georgia?!

The City of Pembroke is planning to utilize these funds for crucial infrastructure enhancements, specifically focused on drainage and sewer improvements within the Lucious Drive area.

This project aims to provide significant benefits to 328 individuals, with the majority being low-to-moderate income residents, accounting for 81.4% of the beneficiaries.

The total project cost amounts to \$1,137,172, with \$222,522 coming from a matching fund and leveraging additional resources for the project's successful implementation.
