Notice of Hydrant-Flushing

The City of Pembroke takes great pride in providing safe drinking water for its citizens and visitors. We have been working diligently to address instances of discolored and murky water. Our next step is a city-wide hydrant flush throughout the month of October to remove sediments and clear up discoloration.

During the flushing process, things typically get a little worse before they get a lot better.

If you experience discoloration or sediment in your water, do not be alarmed as it will clear after a minute or two of running. We suggest you run the cold water from the faucet (or better yet outdoor spigot) closest to the meter. On days when your block or neighborhood is flushing, do not wash white or light-colored clothes.

Please know that your water is safe for all intended purposes and slightly higher amounts of chlorine are added during this time.

We also use this opportunity to test and inspect each hydrant to ensure operation in the event of a fire so you will see fire crews moving with the water department.

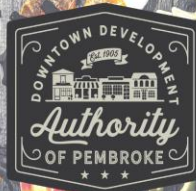
